## Crochet Flower Necklace cum Bracelet

|  | A crocheted flower necklace in lame silver thread which can double up as a bracelet. The necklace is simple to make and takes less than an hour from start to finish. It is a great project for small amounts of leftover yarn. |
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|  | Materials: <br> - 4 ply lame silver thread (or any leftover yarn) <br> - $3.5 \mathrm{~mm} / 4.0 \mathrm{~mm}$ crochet hook <br> - metal clasp / fastener <br> - 6 small pearl beads / shiny beads <br> - gray thread for sewing <br> - embroidery needle <br> Abreviations: <br> ch = chain <br> $\mathrm{d} c=$ double crochet (American) <br> rep $=$ repeat |
| Step | Method |
| 1. | $1^{\text {st }}$ Flower: Make a flower by using any of the following tutorials or written pattern: <br> http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=92fsuYTAaOU <br> http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=X9MgRpT5fyM <br> http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=L40GIdHORn0 <br> Written Pattern of the 5 petal flower: <br> Magic Circle <br> *Ch 2, dc 2 times into the magic circle, ch2, slip stitch into the magic circle <br> Rep from * to make 4 more petals. <br> Do not cut the yarn. <br> Chain 10. |
| 2. | $2^{\text {nd }}$ Flower: <br> 1. Chain 2 for the first part of the flower petal. <br> 2. Counting from the hook, use the $3^{\text {rd }}$ chain from the hook as your magic circle and crochet <br> the $2^{\text {nd }}$ flower. (Remember you have already completed chain 2 of the first petal). <br> 3. Chain 10. |
